Food & Snacks

Children attending The Wraparound Club will be provided with a light, healthy snack during the session.

Our snack options will typically include bread-based items such as wraps, toast, bagels or sandwiches, alongside fresh fruit. We aim to offer simple, balanced options that children enjoy while helping to refuel them after the school day.

Drinking water will always be available.

If your child has any allergies or dietary requirements, please ensure these are clearly stated on the registration form so we can make appropriate arrangements.

Booking a Place With Us

Our Wraparound Club will begin operating from **1st September 2026** at the start of the new academic year.

To help us plan staffing and ensure we have the correct number of spaces available, we ask parents to register their interest first before securing their place.

Step One - Register Your Interest

The form will ask for:

- Child's name
- Child's school year
- Parent/carer name
- Parent email address
- Contact phone number
- Days required (tick boxes)
- Preferred pick-up time (for after-school club)
- Any medical conditions or allergies

Step Two - Secure Your Space

After submitting the interest form, parents will receive a registration and booking link to confirm their child's place.

This will include:

- Parent registration details
- Confirmation of requested days
- Payment options and terms
- Emergency contact information

Places will be confirmed once the registration process is completed. Places are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Booking a Place With Us

Ad hoc Bookings

Parents will be able to make ad hoc bookings through our online booking system once registered.

- The cut-off time for after-school ad hoc bookings is 8:30am on the day.
- Emergency bookings must be confirmed directly with staff via phone or email, as spaces cannot always be guaranteed.

Important Dates

The Wraparound Club starts on **1st September**.

To secure a place for the start of term, we recommend completing your registration as early as possible.

Booking Changes & Notice Period

Regular booked sessions require four weeks' written notice if you wish to cancel or make changes to your child's scheduled days.

Notice must be submitted via email to the club team. During the notice period, all booked sessions remain payable.

Ad hoc bookings are subject to availability and are non-refundable once confirmed.

Booking Changes & Cancellations

Changes or Cancellations by Parents

Regular booked sessions require four weeks' written notice if you wish to cancel or reduce your child's scheduled days.

Notice must be submitted via email to the club team. During the notice period, all booked sessions will remain payable.

Ad hoc bookings are subject to availability and are non-refundable once confirmed.

If your child is unable to attend a session due to illness or other circumstances, we ask that you inform the club as soon as possible. Unfortunately, missed sessions cannot be refunded.

Changes or Cancellations by The Wraparound Club

In the unlikely event that The Wraparound Club needs to cancel a session due to circumstances beyond our control (for example staff illness, school closures, or severe weather), parents will be notified as soon as possible.

Where a session is cancelled by us, parents will be offered:

- A credit for a future session, or
- A refund for the cancelled session

We will always aim to give as much notice as possible.

Late Collection Policy

We ask that all children are collected promptly at their booked collection time to ensure the smooth running of the club and the safety of all children.

If you are running late, please contact the club as soon as possible.

Children collected after their booked session end time will incur a late collection fee of £5 for every 10 minutes.

Persistent late collection may result in a review of your child's place at the club.

We appreciate parents' cooperation in ensuring all children are collected on time.



Medical Information & Safeguarding

Medical Information

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children attending The Wraparound Club, parents must provide accurate and up-to-date medical information during the registration process. This includes details of:

- Any medical conditions
- Allergies or dietary requirements
- Medication requirements
- Any additional needs that staff should be aware of

If your child requires medication (such as inhalers, EpiPens, or other prescribed medication), this must be clearly stated on the registration form and provided to staff where appropriate.

Parents are responsible for ensuring that all medical information is kept accurate and up to date and must inform the club of any changes as soon as possible.

Where necessary, individual care plans may be discussed with parents to ensure appropriate support is in place.

Safeguarding Reassurance

The safety and wellbeing of every child attending The Wraparound Club is our highest priority.

All staff are fully DBS checked and trained to work with children in a safe, supportive and professional environment. Our team follow clear safeguarding procedures in line with school and national safeguarding guidance.

Children will always be signed in and out of the club, and will only be released to authorised adults listed on their registration form. If someone different is collecting your child, parents must inform the club in advance. Staff may ask for identification where necessary to ensure the safety of all children.

We are committed to providing a safe, inclusive and caring environment where children feel secure, supported and able to enjoy their time at the club.

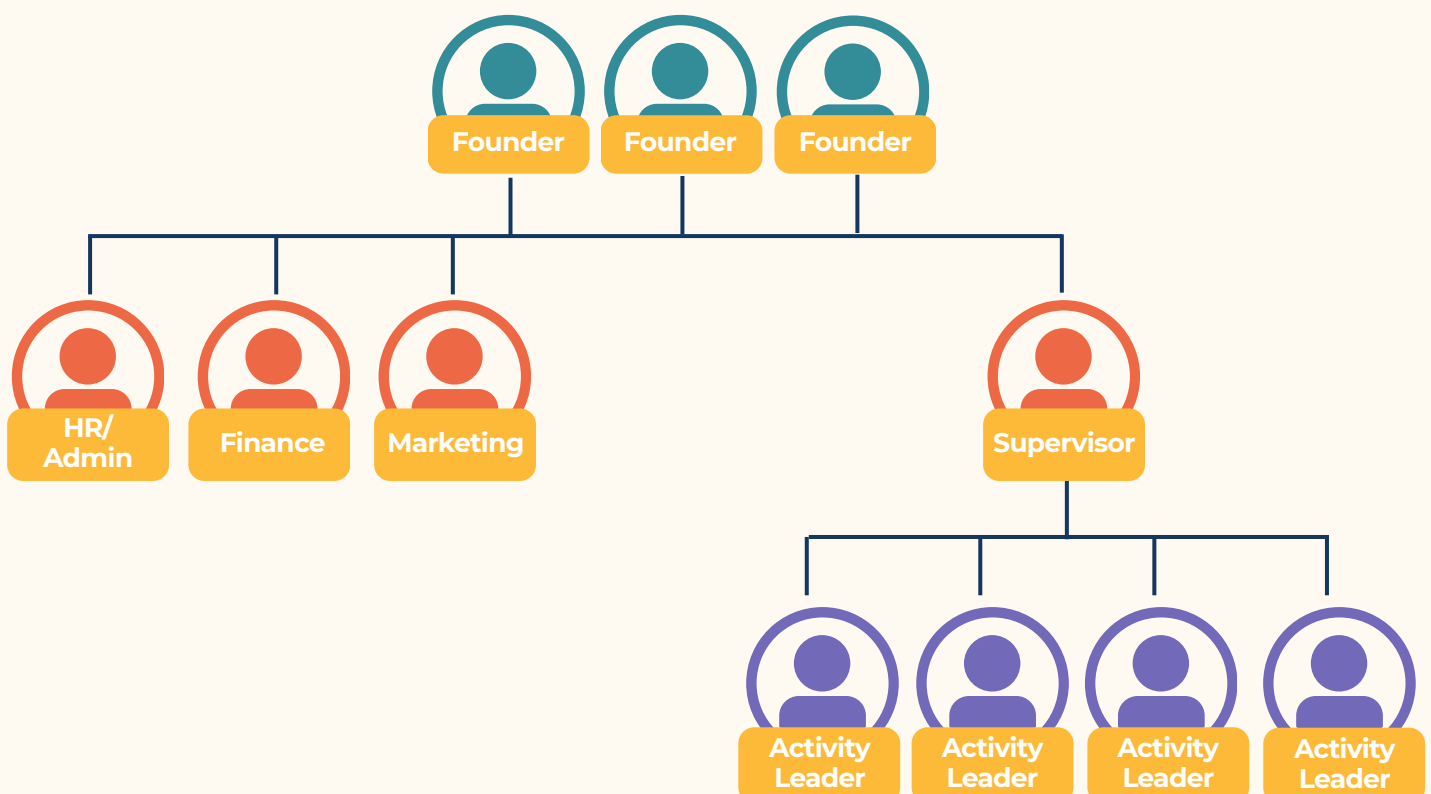
Safer Recruitment Reassurance

We have a full time recruitment team ensuring our leaders are qualified, trained and reference checked.

- All staff are Enhanced DBS checked
- We use bespoke HR Software including qualification recording, document verification, and DBS Update Service automated checks
- All staff are trained to at least Safeguarding Level 1
- We have a Central Designated Safeguarding Team to Level 3
- Staff carry out Prevent Training
- Paediatric First Aid Qualified staff on site at all times

Parent Updates & Staff Communications

All staff members are equipped with two-way radios during club sessions. This allows our team to communicate quickly and effectively across the school site to ensure children are always safe and supervised.



We use WhatsApp and messaging services to keep parents informed about club updates, reminders, and important announcements. This helps ensure clear and quick communication between staff and families.



Parents can also contact the club directly via phone if they need to pass on important information, report a late collection, or speak to a member of the team.

Frequently Asked Questions

What ages can attend the Wraparound Club?

Our club is open to children aged 3–11 years who attend the host school.

What time does the club run?

After School Club: From the end of the school day until 6:30pm depending on the school.

What activities will my child take part in?

Children take part in a variety of fun multi-activities, including:

- Creative play
- Arts and crafts
- Team games
- Board games
- Outdoor activities
- Group challenges

Our aim is to provide a relaxed and enjoyable environment where children can socialise and have fun.

Are snacks or food provided?

Yes.

After School Club: A light snack and drinks are provided.

We always encourage healthy eating and cater for dietary requirements where possible.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I book a place?

Parents can book a regular long-term place using our booking form, and flexible ad hoc sessions are available to book each week on our website. Ad hoc spaces are limited and can only be booked a few days in advance.

What if I am running late for collection?

If you are running late, please contact the club as soon as possible using the club phone number so staff can be informed. Late collection charges may apply if collection is significantly delayed.

How will I know my child is safe?

All staff are DBS checked, trained in safeguarding and first aid, and follow strict school safeguarding policies to ensure children are safe at all times.

Can my child attend on certain days only?

Yes. Parents can usually book specific days that suit their schedule, subject to availability.

What happens if my child has additional needs?

We aim to provide an inclusive environment and will work closely with parents and the school to support children with additional needs wherever possible.
